

Rules:

1. Each player/team must turn in a properly signed, liability waiver form before being allowed to play.
2. Each team will field 5 players (U8-U11) or 6 players (U12 and up), one of whom must be the GK. Each team must have a responsible adult coach on the players' bench during the games.
3. Each game will consist of two (2) twenty-two (27) minute halves, and at most a (2) minute halftime. The clock will not stop during the games.
4. Ball sizes: U8 and under - #3, U10 & U12 - #4, U13 & older- #5.
5. SHIN GUARDS ARE MANDATORY!! Any players not properly equipped will not be allowed to play. Socks must completely cover the shin guards.
6. Due to insurance/liability concerns, no spectators or family members (except coaches) will be allowed on the field or in the players boxes at any time.
7. Kick-off is an INDIRECT kick. The ball may be put in play in any direction, but only touched once, by the player kicking-off.
8. All goals are worth 1 point. Attacking players are not allowed in the goal area. Any goals scored by, or because of (e.g., obstructing the GK) and attacking player in the goal area, will be disallowed.
9. Any ball hitting the netting is considered a dead ball, any must be put back in play within 5 seconds or wit will be a turnover, also and indirect kick.
10. When the ball is being put back in play, defenders are expected to be at least 3 yards from the ball.
11. No "offside".
12. Goalkeeper:- if, during play, the ball is caught or picked up, during "save" situations the keeper must put the ball back in play by throwing it or rolling it to a teammate. The keeper may not put the ball down and kick or dribble it out. No drop-kicks or punts are allowed by the keeper. Also "outdoor rules" apply to the GK handling the ball.
13. No slide-tackling or slide-kicking, any players may not hang on to the die boards to gain leverage/advantage.
14. All kicks resulting from fouls committed OUTSIDE THE PENALTY AREA will be taken from where the foul occurred, and will be INDIRECT.
15. Foul language, arguing a call or no-call, trash-talk, taunting, show-boating, etc by any player will not be tolerated, and will result in, at least, a yellow card.
16. ALL REFEREE CALL ARE FINAL. There will be no contesting/appealing any referee calls or no-calls by players, coaches or parents. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of players and players' parents.
17. Cards:
 - Blue Player out for 5 minutes, team can substitute for the player
 - Yellow: Player out for 5 minutes, team plays short for (2) of those 5 minutes
 - Red: Player ejected from the game and playing area may not play in the next game. Team plays short for 5 minutes.
